- II. Business Literature Festival 2021: BIMTECH organized a one of its kind virtual Business Literature Festival 2021. To encourage budding entrepreneurs and give them interesting insights into successful entrepreneurship, CIED organized a Panel Talk on "Creating Unicorns." - III. Setup Enterprise Lab and Business models (E Lab & BM): It is an experiential core course with the objective of instilling an Entrepreneurial Mindset in students. It provides an opportunity to apply theoretical concepts in real business scenarios to develop real-world skills to lead in a rapidly changing eco-system and become value creators for life. The course aims to develop creative and critical thinking in students for problem solving and decision making with an entrepreneurial mind-set. In the process, they also get a holistic understanding of a business, how it integrates with various functional areas and the future trends as well. Students also realise the critical importance of team work as they collaborate and work as part of a multidisciplinary and multi-cultural team.
- IV. Entrepreneur Internship with AIC: As part of the INTERNSHIP WITH AIC BIMTECH Program, 13 students from BIMTECH and 27 students from other academic institutions such as GL Bajaj, Manav Rachna University, Greater Noida Institute of Technology (GNIOT), and JIMS Engineering Management Technical Campus (JEMTEC) interned over the summer. The two interrelated purposes of the program are to contribute to the training of interns and gain meaningful assistance from them in furthering the activities of the AIC. The program included assigning interns to tasks compatible with their professional interests and/or needs. During the program's duration, Interns worked up to 30 hours per week and at the same time continued their learning and education.



V. E-cell of BIMTECH Programs:
