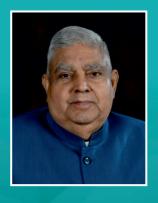

The graduating class included 713 students, with 18 medalists honored for academic excellence.

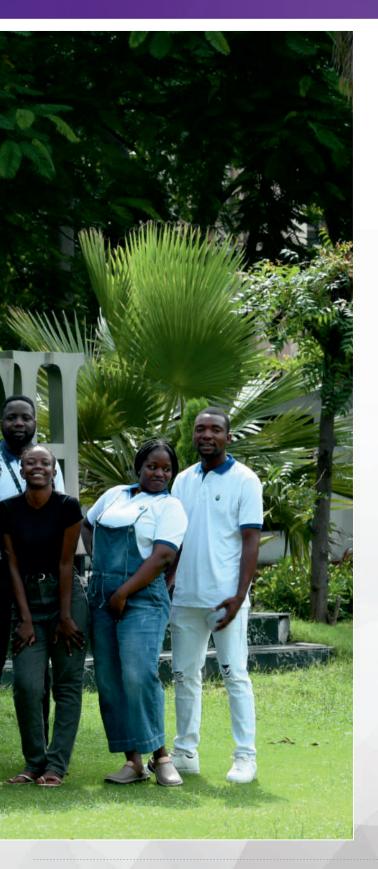

1. **BIMTECH** goes global!

Aligned with the NEP 2020's vision of making India as a potential destination for international students, BIMTECH, home to students from all parts of India, welcomed 31 international students in its 2-year full-time PGDM program in the academic year 2024-25. The presence of international students in campus has enhanced the cross-cultural exchanges, fostering diversity in the campus. Presence of international students in BIMTECH aligns with the institution's commitment to excellence, diversity, and the holistic development of its students.

2. **International Student Mobility**

BIMTECH has a well-established Student Exchange Program under which student mobility takes place annually. By participating in the Student Exchange Program of BIMTECH, students gain a deeper understanding of diverse cultures, enhance their language skills, foster global networks, and develop the cross-cultural competencies required to thrive in an increasingly globalized job market.

Under the Student Exchange program, outgoing mobility, 21 BIMTECH students pursued their exchange trimesters in Sydney Business School, University of Wollongong-Australia, FH Joanneum-Austria, ESSCA, Angers-France, Excelia Business School-France, Léonard de Vinci Business School (ALDV)-France, NEOMA Business School, France University of Warsaw-Poland and Solbridge University, South Korea.

BIMTECH's India Study Program: Unlocking Diversity, **Igniting Sustainability**

The "India Study Program", a short term immersion program was organised by the Centre for International Affairs from 9-18 February 2025 aimed at master students from FH Vorarlberg, Austria with a thematic focus on "Diversity and Sustainable Development in India". The program offered the participants from diverse backgrounds a comprehensive understanding of India's multifaceted approach to addressing environmental, social, and economic challenges. Global Immersion Program at National University of Singapore (NUS) and Singapore Management University (SMU):

a) National University of Singapore (NUS)

11 students from BIMTECH were selected to participate in the 1-week Global Immersion Program from July 7-13, 2024 on Al-Powered Business Analytics, at the National University of Singapore (NUS), which is the world's 8th ranked university. The program equipped students with both theoretical knowledge and hands-on skills in Business Analytics driven by Artificial Intelligence. The program featured Classroom Training Sessions, an Industry Visit, Cultural Exposure, Project Work, and Final Presentations.

b) Singapore Management University (SMU)

25 students from BIMTECH were selected for an Inclusive and Immersive Experiential Learning Program at Singapore Management University from March 31 – April 4, 2025. During the program, BIMTECH students engaged in a series of enriching activities at SMU, including course work, tackling real world challenges through a live project assigned by a company and visits to the Singapore Stock Exchange which helped them gain valuable insights into international industry practices.

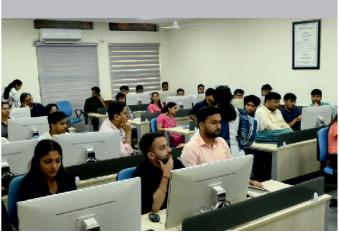
BLOOMBERG FINANCE LAB

The Bloomberg Finance Lab has had an exceptionally productive year, solidifying its role as a cornerstone for practical, industryrelevant financial education. With a strong focus on student engagement, certifications, and applied learning, the lab has set new benchmarks.

Key Highlights & Achievements

- Record Certifications: 480 students completed the Bloomberg Market Concepts (BMC) certification, reflecting their growing commitment to mastering global financial markets.
- Bloomberg Champion Program: We successfully trained and certified a new cohort of 15 Bloomberg Student Champions. These champions have been instrumental in peer-to-peer mentoring, assisting over 400 students with terminal navigation, module completion, and data analytics projects.
- **Workshops:** Five high-impact sessions covered themes such as Equity Research, ESG Investing, and Fixed Income Analytics.
- Curriculum Integration: The Bloomberg Terminal was embedded into three new courses—Corporate Finance, Responsible Business, and Financial Accounting—where students applied real-time data to assessments, case studies, and capstone projects.





MARKETING & RETAIL RESEARCH LAB - A STRATEGIC BEHAVIORAL INSIGHT INITIATIVE AT BIMTECH





BIMTECH is establishing the Marketing & Retail Research Lab, equipped with an advanced Eye Tracking solution, as part of its strategic efforts to enhance research, experiential learning, and industry engagement across all PGDM programs. This lab will support in-depth exploration of consumer attention and behavior by analyzing real-time eye movements, gaze paths, fixation points, and viewing patterns on digital interfaces.

The Eye Tracking system enables faculty and students to conduct research in areas such as consumer psychology, neuromarketing, digital advertising, user interface evaluation, and cross-cultural behavior analysis. It provides a practical framework for understanding how users engage with marketing content, websites, and retail layouts in a digital setting.

The lab will also support curriculum delivery through hands-on projects, classroom demonstrations, and student-led experiments. It will enhance the academic experience by integrating practical behavioral data into teaching and allow for faculty-led research, academic publications, and collaboration with industry on live projects.





BIMTECH PARTNERS WITH KALP DECENTRA FOUNDATION TO LAUNCH STATE-OF-THE-ART BLOCKCHAIN LEARNING CENTER AND INTRODUCE BIMCOIN, A CAMPUS DIGITAL CURRENCY

BIMTECH has signed an MoU with Kalp Decentra Foundation, USA, to set up a **state-of-the-art Blockchain Learning Center** on campus. This initiative strengthens BIMTECH's focus on academic excellence through technology-driven learning. The Center aims to:

- Provide hands-on blockchain training and simulations.
- Empower students, faculty, and professionals with practical skills in blockchain technology.
- Foster innovation and interdisciplinary research.
- Build industry-ready talent for the digital economy.

Alongside the Center, BIMTECH and Kalp Decentra Foundation have co-developed **BIMCOIN**, a blockchain-based digital currency for secure and transparent campus transactions.

CENTRE FOR RESEARCH



DOCTORAL PROGRAMME

BIMTECH's Executive/Fellow Programme in Management (E/FPM) is designed to develop the next generation of management faculty as global thought leaders. The programme aims to transform young researchers into innovative thinkers and effective problem-solvers. The E/FPM, approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), is a doctoral-level program. Recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as equivalent to a Ph.D. degree from an Indian university for four years (from July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2028).

The program leverages the extensive research strengths of BIMTECH's faculty, who possess cutting-edge expertise. With a curriculum that is both academically rigorous and highly relevant to today's globalized business environment, the E/FPM is well-equipped to meet the dynamic needs of our society.

A total of 6 research scholars were admitted to the E/FPM doctoral level programmes in the academic year of 2025-26. At the beginning of the year there were 39 doctoral students registered with the center. Five scholars have submitted their thesis and three scholars were awarded doctoral degrees.

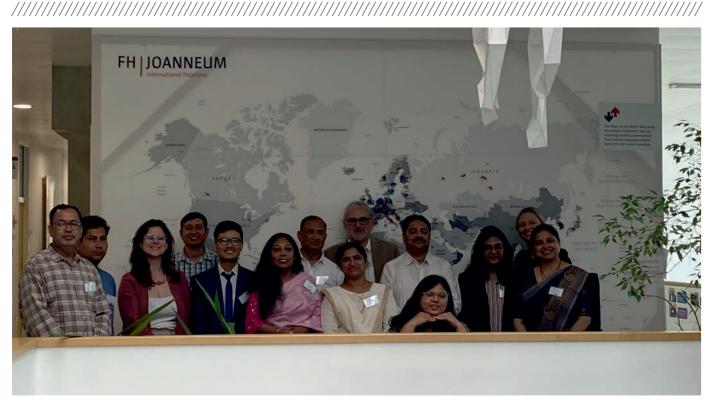

AIDEdu PROJECT



During 2024–25, BIMTECH played a leading role in the EU-funded AIDEdu Project, advancing accessible, inclusive, and digitized management education across India and Nepal. Activities spanned capacity building, national and institutional initiatives, and the creation of Centres of Excellence in Teaching & Learning (T&L), all strongly aligned to SDGs 4, 10, and 17.

Global Capacity Building

BIMTECH faculty Dr. Himanshi Tiwari and Dr. Shreya Mishra began the year's engagements with intensive training at Riga Technical University, Latvia, followed by a second program at F.H. Joanneum, Austria. Later, they joined consortium activities at the University of Alicante, Spain, and visited partner institutions in Cartagena and Barcelona, building momentum for cross-border academic collaboration.

National & Institutional Initiatives

On August 24th, 2024, The Economic Times – Government featured BIMTECH's leadership role in the €719,953 AIDEdu Project, highlighting its responsibility in establishing Centres of Excellence and advancing inclusive, digitized management education. This momentum continued in November 2024 with the launch of the official AIDEdu webpage, centralizing project updates, events, and resources for a broad stakeholder base.

BCALL Launch & Student Engagement

On June 23rd, 2025, BIMTECH inaugurated BCALL – the BIMTECH Centre of Education for All, equipped with assistive technologies to promote inclusion and accessibility for diverse learners. Soon after, BCALL conducted a Situation Analysis Survey during Immersion Week for first-year PGDM students, gathering insights on inclusivity, digital access, and learning support to shape future initiatives.







IMPACT ON SUSPENSION OF COMMODITY DERIVATIVES ON COMMODITY MARKET ECOSYSTEM

During 2024–25, BIMTECH played a leading role in the NCDEX project on "Impact on Suspension of Commodity Derivatives on Commodity Market Ecosystem".

BIMTECH faculty Dr Prabina Rajib and Dr. Ruchi Arora along with Prof Parama Barai (IIT, Kharagpur) took this project initiated by NCDEX. The project is about the SEBI's suspension of seven commodities in the derivative segment. Dr Prabina shared the findings of the report with the media on ET news, Zee business and other media coverage took place.

ADAPTIVE RISK ASSESSMENT OF LOAN APPLICANTS

Prof. Ram Mohan Dhara, BIMTECH, led a consulting engagement with a financial loan underwriting company to strengthen risk assessment methods for underserved borrowers, particularly those lacking conventional credit records. The project focused on developing adaptive psychometric techniques to evaluate applicant behavior more accurately. The study outcomes provide a pathway for more inclusive, data-driven credit evaluation, highlighting BIMTECH's expertise in applied research and innovative financial solutions.

SEGMENTING INDIAN FARMERS FOR TARGETED FERTILIZER STRATEGIES

Prof. Ram Mohan Dhara, BIMTECH, led a farmer segmentation study in collaboration with a Rural Management Consulting Firm, commissioned by a multi-national agrochemicals company to strengthen understanding of India's agricultural ecosystem. The project focused on identifying distinct farmer profiles based on fertilizer usage patterns, cropping systems, technology adoption, and willingness to pay. The research identified distinct farmer personas, reflecting both psychographic and behavioral diversity, and providing actionable insights for more effective engagement of different groups. The study's outcomes will enable the company to design targeted fertilizer strategies, enhance outreach, and promote sustainable farming.

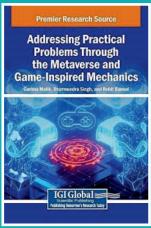

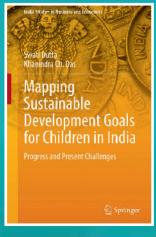

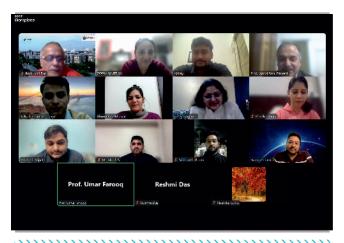
FDP AND PANEL DISCUSSION ON RESPONSIBLE LEADERSHIP AT BIMTECH

ANNUAL CONVOCATION 2025 FOR PGDM (ONLINE) BATCH



COOLS celebrated its third annual convocation on 5 May 2025, alongside the regular PGDM program, for online batches Jan 2023–Dec 2024 and July 2022–June 2024. In PGDM (Online), with a male-to-female ratio of 5:2, 76% of learners from Cohort 4 and 74% of learners from Cohort 5 met academic standards and graduated successfully.

Campus Immersion for the learners of PGDM Online program was organized from May **9th to May 12th, 2025**. The program commenced with a welcome address and inaugural messages from Director Dr. Prabina Rajib, Deputy Director & Dean (Academics) Dr. Pankaj Priya, and Prof. Manoj Pant, Chairperson of COOLS. On the final day, a keynote session by Mr. Sandeep Tyagi, CHRO of Samsung, offered valuable insights on leadership and HR. Overall, the program blended academics, industry insights, skill-building, and cultural engagement, ensuring a holistic learning experience while fostering stronger connections between students, faculty, and industry leaders.





Centre For Admissions



BIMTECH Admissions for 2025 commenced with the launch of the online application form on 17 September 2024.

This year's admission cycle witnessed a notable rise in the number of eligible applicants across various programs. It was an enriching journey where we successfully replicated and enhanced last year's initiatives, including the use of digital and social media for student engagement, the Extempore & PI process, and a student/alumni referral scheme. Additionally, selected candidates were able to upload their required documents directly through their dashboards, further digitizing the admission process.

This initiative streamlined operations, minimized errors, ensured transparency, and made the process entirely paperless. The strong response from applicants resulted in the successful selection of high-quality candidates, with all PGDM programs achieving full capacity. As of August 2025, the course-wise admission status is as follows:

Once again, the Commerce stream led admissions, contributing 36% of the total intake, followed by Engineering graduates at 20%. Other streams constituted the remaining intake. A total of 183 female students joined across all programs, resulting in a male-to-female ratio of 63:37.

Our ongoing international outreach also bore fruit, attracting 13 students from Nepal and Zimbabwe. Additionally, dependence on the northern region has decreased compared to previous years, while enrolments from the eastern and central regions increased.

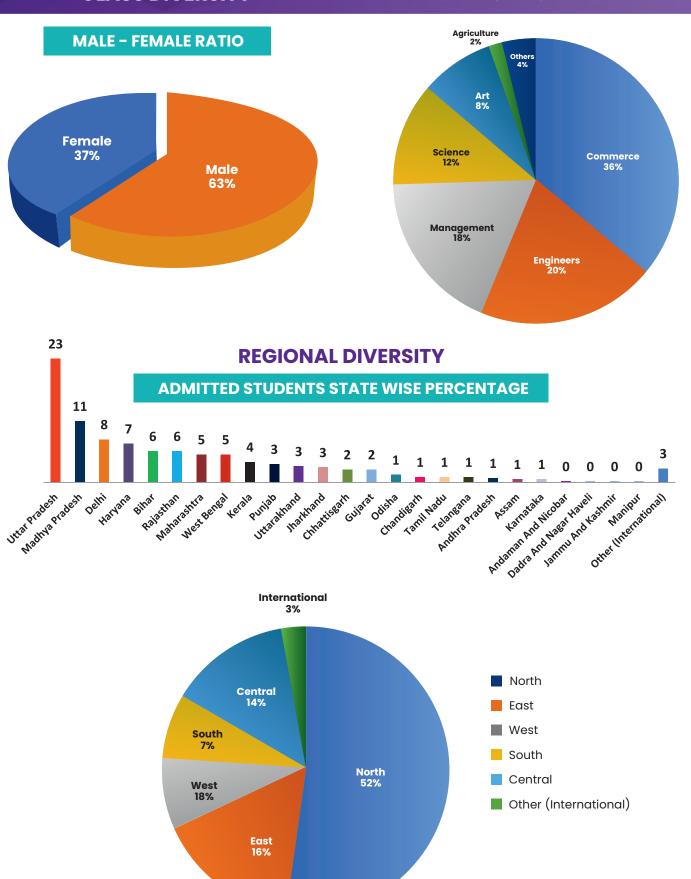

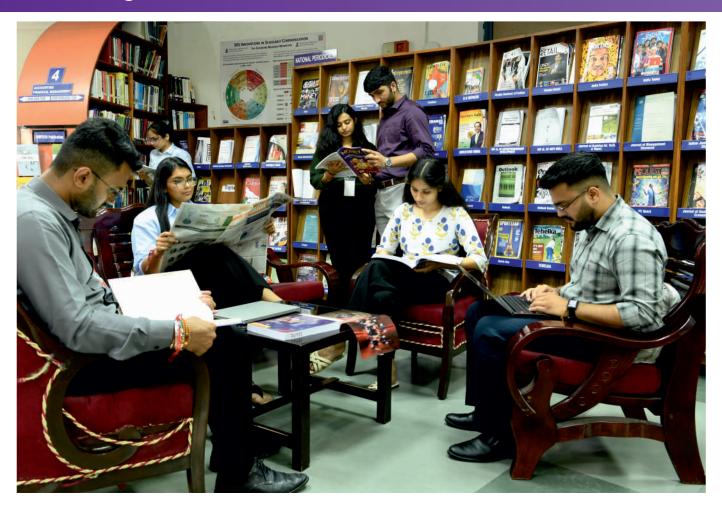
Internship-to-Placement Conversion

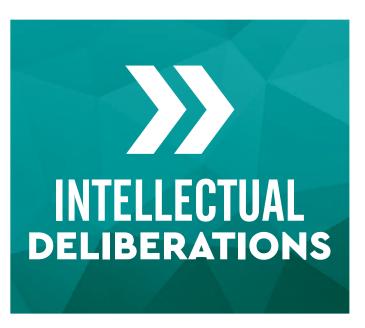
Quick Commerce

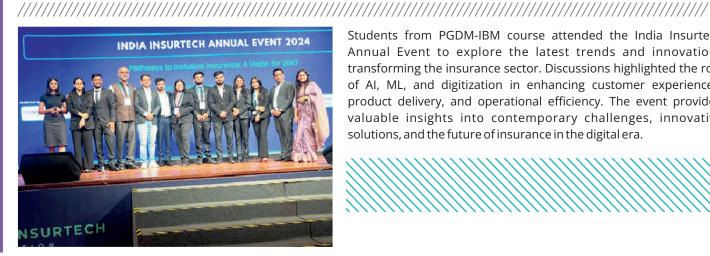


Discovering Innovation Beyond Borders: SMU I2XL

The lab features glass partitions for transparency, modern furniture with specialized equipment, research-focused decor, and lighting tailored to lab needs, creating an environment that fosters innovative research in behavioural and visual tracking studies.

4. Development of B-Cell Office

A dedicated B-Cell Office was developed on the first floor of the Academic Block.

Furnished with ergonomic furniture, advanced lighting, and modern interiors.

Provides an efficient, professional space for student engagement and activities.

5. Upgradation of HVAC System in Hostel Blocks

A major HVAC system upgrade was completed in the Takshshila and Nalanda Hostel Blocks, covering all 424 student rooms. The 20-year-old centralized AC plant was replaced with a modern VRF system, featuring a new gas-based pipeline that prevents moisture issues. Individual indoor units in each room provide personalized cooling, enhancing energy efficiency, space utilization, and student comfort.

6. Replacement of Firefighting System

The campus firefighting system, in place for over two decades, was replaced to meet enhanced safety standards. Damaged underground pipelines were replaced with a new above-ground system, ensuring stronger water pressure, higher reliability, faster emergency response, and enhanced campus safety and disaster preparedness.
