Dharma Plastics Ltd., Ghaziabad (U.P.)

Dharma Plastics Ltd., Ghaziabad (U.P.)is a factory attached with a retail store. Primarily dealing with manufacturing and retailing of plastic jars and kitchenware, it is also involved in some inter and intra state sales and purchases. It employs 250 regular and 58 casual workmen. In its retail store it employees 60 staff members including 12 managers and rest at different non executive levels. Manoj is working as a cook in its pantry, he has just know attained the age of 13 years. The manager asks him to bring two persons approximately of his age for some other related issues connected with the retail store. Mr Manoj brings his friend Mahesh and Sunil who are 12 and 15 years old respectively, who were subsequently inducted in the store. Later the ALC (Additional Labour Commissioner) and the Sales Inspector visited the same unit and identified certain discrepancies in its functioning which requires some clarification.
